### Deb's Boot Camp

Spend three days working in the studio creating a quilt from start to finish ... yes I said start to finish that even means quilting & binding it. Spend the weekend playing laughing and creating. Everything is provided in other- words you get to play in Deb's stash & with her tools. Lap size quilt will be the end results. Meals are provided. Once you have taken this class you can also rent our machines .

## Longarm Machine Rental

The Millennium can be rented for \$25 per hour (two hour minimum) or \$150 dollars for the whole day.

George - Sit down Longarm can be rented for \$10 per hour (two hour minimum). The first hour is free. Day rate \$50 dollars.

Trained specialists are on hand to assist with anything. You schedule the time that works for you and your schedule.

## Professional Quilting Service

Bring your finished quilt top in and let's discuss your quilting options.

Edge to Edge quilting pricing is  $\$0.020 - \$0.030$  per sq. in. Length.

Take Length x Width x .022 = most freehand quilting.
